Galatians 5:1-6 (HCSB)

1 Christ has liberated us to be free. Stand firm then and don't submit again to a yoke of slavery.

2 Take note! I, Paul, tell you that if you get yourselves circumcised, Christ will not benefit you at all.



Galatians 5:1-6 (HCSB)

³ Again I testify to every man who gets himself circumcised that he is obligated to keep the entire law.

⁴ You who are trying to be justified by the law are alienated from Christ; you have fallen from grace.



Galatians 5:1-6 (HCSB)

⁵ For through the Spirit, by faith, we eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness.

⁶ For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision accomplishes anything; what matters is faith working through love.



1. Christ has Set Us Free

¹ Christ has liberated us to be free.

- **Patrick Henry cried out give me liberty or give me death**
- **Christ cries out give me death to give you liberty**
- **His death has set us free**



2. Christ Alone Justifies

4 You who are trying to be justified by the law are alienated from Christ; “

Paul's primary point in this passage, as throughout the letter, is that law and grace cannot be mixed.
