14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.


15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

1 John 5:11-21 (NKJV)




There is sin *leading* to death. I do not say that he should pray about that. ¹⁷ All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not *leading* to death. ¹⁸ We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him. ¹⁹ We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies *under the sway* of the wicked one.

¹⁹ We know that we are of God,


- **Born again**
