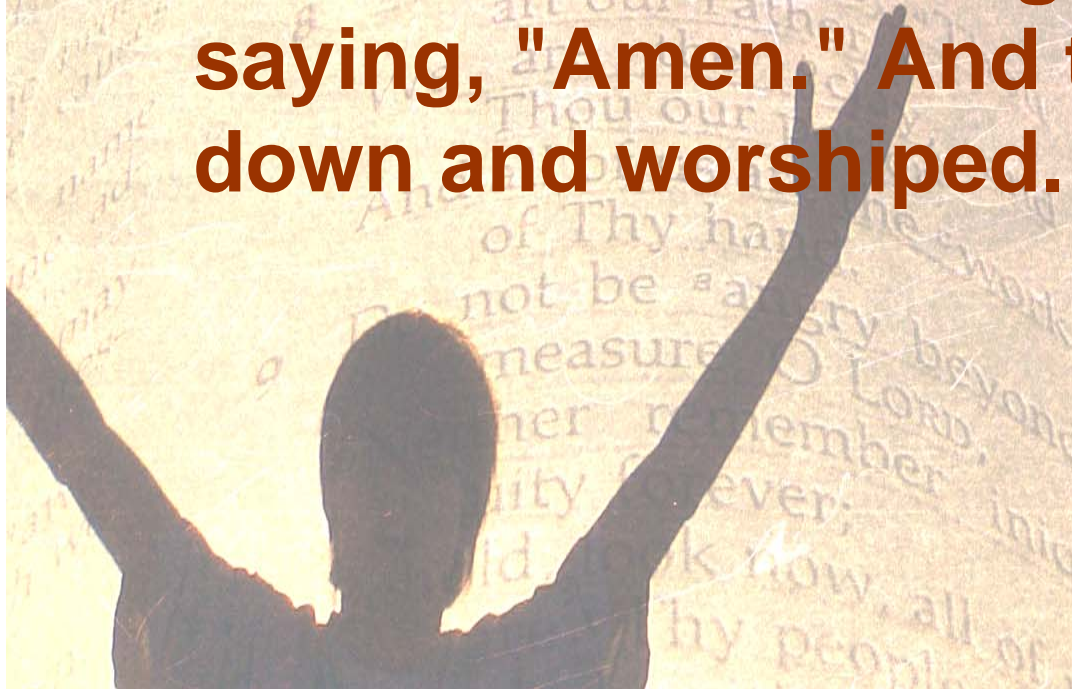

the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb,

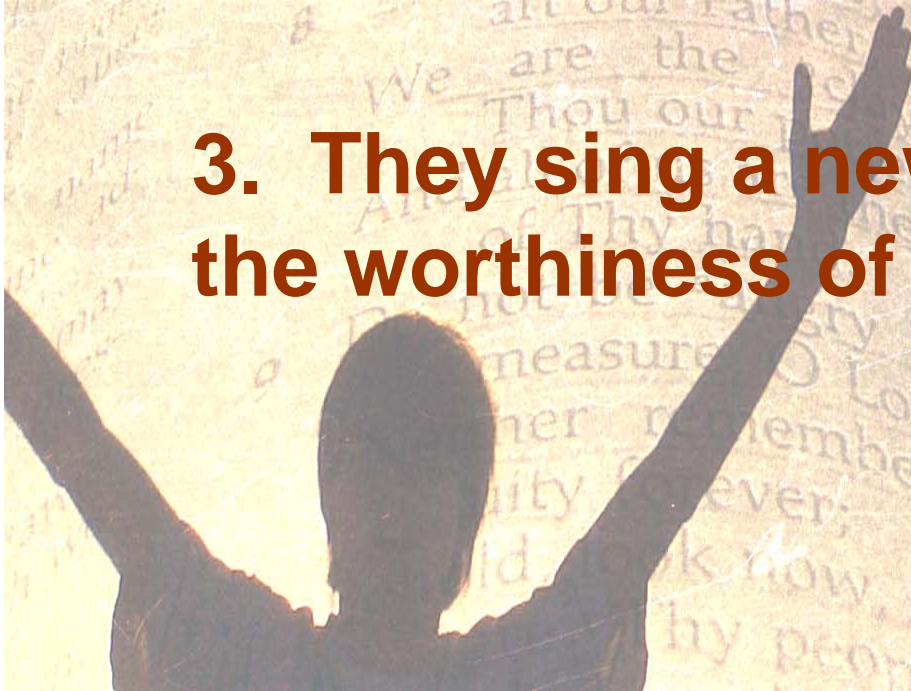
1. They fall down before Christ, the Lamb of God

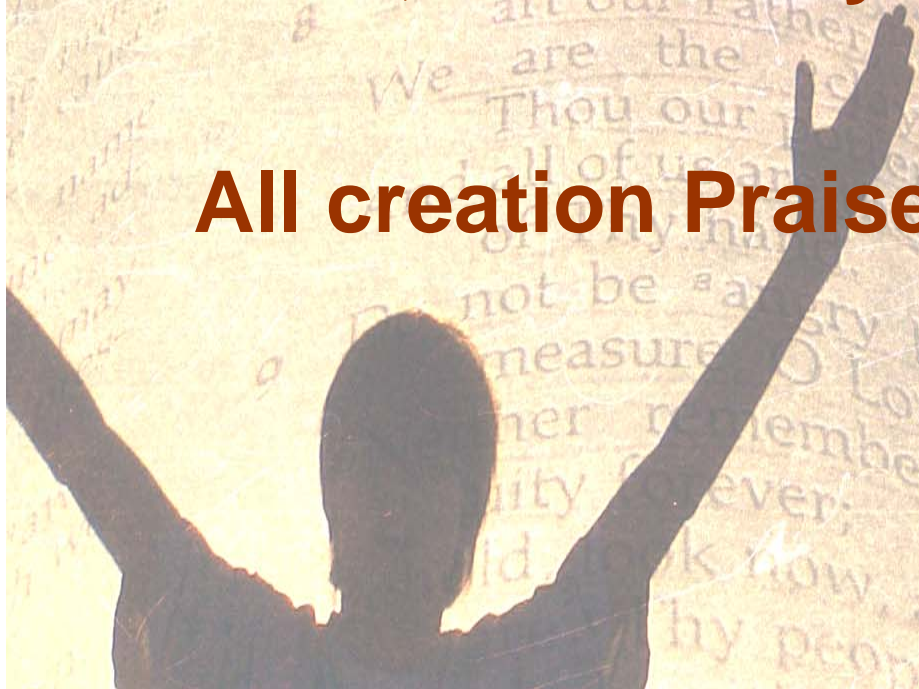

2. The Realm of Worship

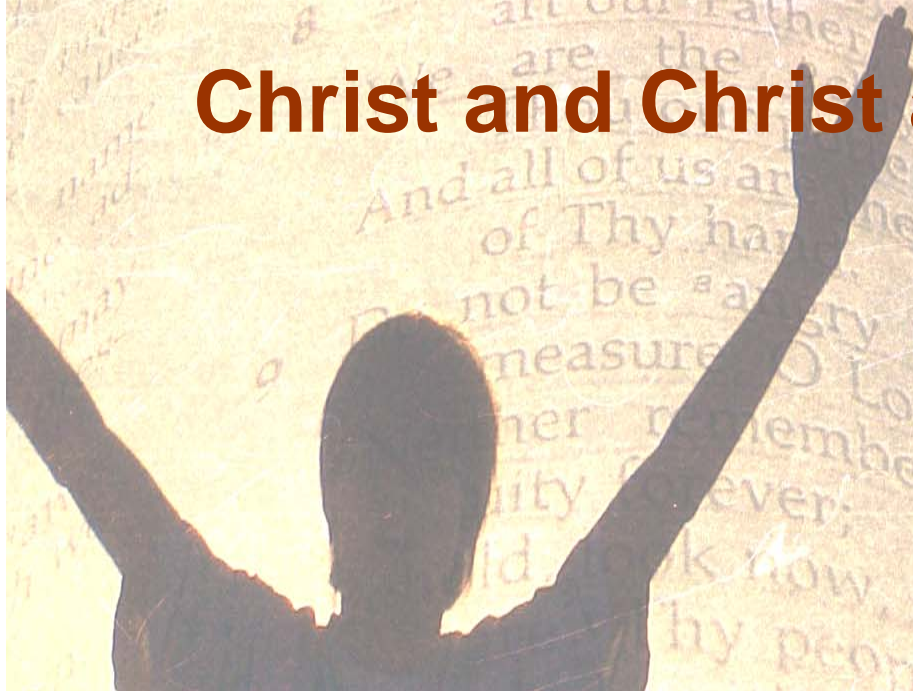
All creation Praises Him
