

Series: The Road Less Traveled



Colossians 2:6-7 (HCSB)
6 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, walk in Him,
7 rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

1. Rooted in him.

UNSTABLE: NO ROOTS TO HOLD

It comes down to this: WE become rooted in Christ by surrendering ourselves in faith to Christ; the more we surrender, the deeper the roots grow.

2. Built Up by Him.

UNSTABLE: OUR WALLS LOW

"built up in Christ" is an on-going process--one that takes time. Becoming like Christ is a process that takes time. This does not give us an excuse to sin; it gives us a reason to keep trying.



3. Strengthened through Him
UNSTABLE: WE HAVE NO
STRENGTH

**We do not have any
strength in ourselves, the
strength is in our faith.**

4. Giving Thanks to Him

UNSTABLE: Not THANKFUL

Paul says that we should be overflowing with thankfulness towards Christ for what he has promised to do in our life.
